I hope our entire Edmund Rice College community had a very happy, safe, and restful Christmas break.

As I am sure you are aware, the Education Minister has announced revised plans for schools reopening in January due to the increase in Covid-19 cases. All pupils were due to return to school in Edmund Rice College on Tuesday 5th January 2021. In line with the new guidance, the following changes will now be in place:

Remote Learning from Wednesday 6th January

All pupils will now be taught remotely during the first week in January. Staff will use Tuesday 5th January 2021 to plan and prepare for this change. Online learning will commence for all pupils on Wednesday 6th January via Google Classroom. Work will be set for each subject over the course of this week. Provision for vulnerable children and children of key workers

Edmund Rice College will accommodate vulnerable children and the children of key workers from Wednesday 6th January for supervised learning. This will not be 'face-to-face teaching', rather being supervised in school, doing the same activities as the children at home.
